

STUDENT RELEASE DURING SCHOOL HOURS

Students will be allowed to leave the school district facilities during their lunch period only with prior authorization from their parents. Seniors will be allowed to leave school facilities during the day in compliance with the administrative rules adopted annually by the board.

If a student needs to leave school district facilities during the school day, the parent must either send a note, call the principal's office or appear personally. Approved reasons for release of a student during the school day shall include, but not be limited to, illness, family emergencies, medical appointments, religious instruction, classes outside the student's attendance center, employment for which the student has been issued a work permit, and other reasons determined by the superintendent.

It shall be the responsibility of the superintendent, in conjunction with the principal, to develop administrative regulations regarding this policy,
