- Preliminary informational meetings with school board and advisory committees
- Involve parents, students, and community members to gain input on ICC implementation
- Staff, board, and district partners will review the vision during the 2010-2011 school year to ensure the Iowa Core is included in vision and district philosophy
- Leadership Team will engage in discussion with the school board regarding progress on the Iowa Core Curriculum
- Information posted on district WEB site 2010-2012
- Work on aligning curriculum during the 2010-2011 school year using ICAT tool
- Final recommendation to the school board during the 2011-2012 school year for grades 7-12 and the 2012-2013 school year for grades K-6
- Staff will incorporate the essential concepts during curriculum mapping during 2010-2011
- Observations and evaluations will start during the 2011-2012 school year
- Staff will complete the work and the observation and evaluation system to monitor staff in the use of the Iowa Teaching standards
- Conduct a survey in the fall of 2010 during parent-teacher conferences to determine the community's understanding of the vision for the Iowa Core
- District will monitor data from the Perkins reports to determine gaps that exist in the 21st Century Skills in the Vocational Curriculum
- Administration and Vocational teachers will review data and gaps in Vocational or gen ed curriculum to meet the requirements of the 21st Century Skills
- Conduct a self-survey during the 2010-2011 in-service days as annually review activity
