

STUDENT INSURANCE

All students shall be required to have health and/or accident insurance. The parent must sign a waiver stating there is adequate insurance protection.

Ruthven-Ayrshire encourages parents/families to participate in an accident insurance program, and if there is not one available through the school, the district may make referrals to local insurance agencies.

The cost of any accident insurance program shall be borne by the student. Participation in any insurance accident plan is not a contract with the school district, but rather, a contract between the insurance company and the student.

Whenever a student is injured while under the supervision of an employee, the employee will file an accident report with the school health clerk and the principal's office within twenty-four hours.
